During the investigation, Detectives learned that Bartholomew and Scott were involved in an altercation in the 400 block of Killona Drive in Killona, LA. During the altercation, Bartholomew and Scott allegedly exchanged gunfire. Bartholomew sustained a non-life threatening gunshot wound to his leg and transported himself to a New Orleans Hospital for treatment. Scott did not sustain any injuries during the incident.
